Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) is an assessment process that gives recognition for the knowledge and skills that you have acquired through your work experience, formal education, training and life experiences. The RPL process involves matching your knowledge and skills to the learning outcomes of nationally recognised qualifications to determine whether you should be given credit for specific units of competency or even for the whole qualification. A qualification awarded through RPL is identical to one earned in the traditional (classroom) way.
